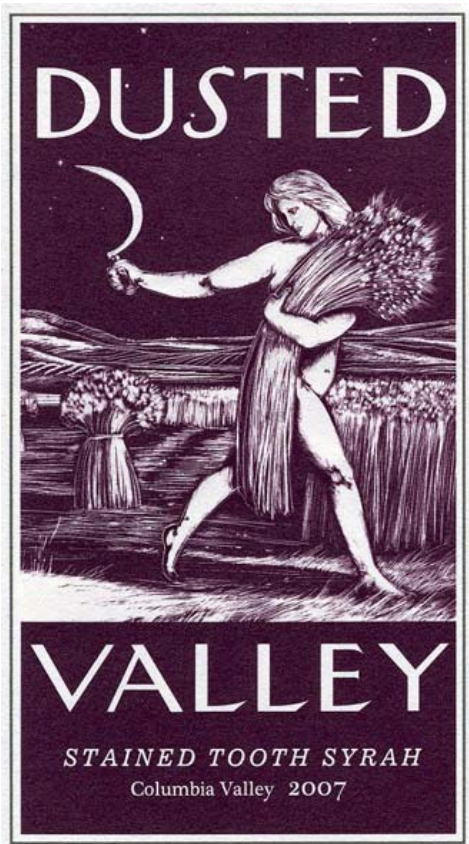

### WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Purple is our favorite color. You know you're drinking the good stuff when your teeth develop that unmistakable hue. Don't worry, Chad's father Dr. Dan Johnson D.D.S. says, "Life is too short to stain your teeth on cheap wine." This is a blend of some of Washington State's top vineyards incorporating a co-ferment of Syrah and Viognier in the tradition of Cote Rotie. Then again, we couldn't leave the Southern Rhone out of the picture so the blend received the beauty of Grenache and Counoise. The bouquet floats out of the glass and draws you into all the extraordinary fruit while the ripe tannins provide a silky finish. Be sure to enjoy this bottle with a grilled rack of lamb encrusted with rosemary and thyme over a hickory fire. **WARNING: May make a meal memorable.**
